### Casual Position

*William Carey Christian School is committed to transforming lives by the proclamation of the gospel and the delivery of an excellent and affordable Christian education, accessible to the whole community.*

WCCS currently has positions available for casual cleaners to join our well-established team. Reporting to the Head Cleaner, you will form part of an experienced cleaning team that takes pride in presenting clean and spotless school facilities each morning to 1,300 students.

Spread over ten hectares, you will be required to be involved in all cleaning duties including classrooms, toilets and general tidying of playground and garden areas. The role is a casual position for up to 6.5 hours a day. You are expected to be able to work within the school needs which require a split shift arrangement. This will involve a 5:00 am to 8:30 am shift following by an afternoon shift from 3:00 pm to 6:00 pm. Longer hours may be needed in school holiday periods for regular property maintenance jobs.

#### Essential Criteria:

- Be able to fully subscribe to the School's Statement of Faith
- A commitment to seeing the school deliver an excellent and affordable Christian education
- The ability to work effectively among a team of cleaners
- Well-developed communication skills
- The ability to meet the physical demands involved in this position - experience in a similar role will be looked upon favourably
- Successful candidates will be required to obtain a Working With Children Check clearance before commencing employment.

- To share the gospel with students and parents, pointing them to Christ
