#### Framework (Head, Heart and Hands):

- **Hands** (the practical component of what you do: administration, stewardship, implementation in our situation).

**Essential Criteria:**

- A commitment to seeing the school deliver an excellent Christian education
- Be able to demonstrate the capacity to be an excellent music tutor of percussion/drums, or woodwind and/or brass
- Have appropriate music qualifications
- Be willing to attend and contribute to major school music performance events
- Have experience in coordinating and conducting small ensembles (desirable)
- Be able to demonstrate the capacity to work harmoniously with others, whether in supervisory, collegial or advisory contexts.
- Excellent interpersonal skills including relationship building skills
- The successful candidates will be required to obtain a Working With Children Check clearance before commencing employment.
